-  • **Oshino Hakkai:** A series of eight ponds fed by Mt. Fuji's underground reservoir. The clean, clear mineral-rich ponds, nestled in the scenic village of Oshino.
-  • **Lake Kawaguchi Maple Corridor:** Breathtakingly stunning Maple Corridor close to Mt. Fuji!
- Enjoy a Japanese onsen bath.

## DAY 3

Hakone – Kamakura - Tokyo

## DAY 4

Tokyo

- **Sensoji Temple:** Also known as Asakusa Kannon Temple, it is name after ‘**Kannon**’ – Goodness of Mercy
- **Nakamise- Dori Street** : It is one of the oldest shopping streets in Japan. There are more than 100 storeson both sides on road, selling a variety of local specialties, food and souvenirs.
- **Gotokuji Temple:** Tokyo's Maneki Neko 'Lucky Cat' Temple.
- **Jingu Gaien Ginkgo Avenue** : There are many ginkgo trees ( also known as Ginkgo Avenue Tokyo or Icho Namiki Avenue ) in Meiji-Jingu Gaien.
- **Tokyo Metropolitan Government Building Observation Room** : Where you can get to see panoramic view of the city. Rewarded with view of Odaiba and as far as Mt.Fuji from the south observation desk.
- **Shinjuku Kabuki Cho** : One of the best known entertainment and red-light district in Japan.
