第一天 吉隆坡 - 厦门 (机上用餐)


酒店：厦门柏纳 S 或同级

集合于吉隆坡国际机场，办理登机手续后飞往 厦门机场，接机后入住酒店休息。

第二天 厦门 2.5 小时 - 永定 2 小时 - 梅州 (早/簸箕盆菜/韩式烤肉)

酒店：梅州有权国际大酒店或同级

早餐后，前往永定游览【洪坑土楼民俗文化村-土楼王子振成楼】是世界上最神奇的山区居民建筑，土楼群历史悠久、风格独特、规模宏大、结构精巧，是中国古民居建筑中的一朵奇葩，被誉为“东方文明的一颗璀璨明珠”。后前往梅州游览【客家博物馆 (周一闭馆)】是国内首家全面展示客家民系文化渊源与发展，系统收藏、整理、研究、展示客家历史文物与客家民俗文物的综合性博物馆。【千佛塔】佛塔二至八层墙内镶嵌千尊汉白玉佛，九层供奉千尊鎏金铜佛，塔顶托起一座七层小石塔，形成塔中有塔，塔上有塔、铁佛、玉佛、金佛共容一塔的“三千佛塔”的艺术特色。



第三天 梅州 3 小时 - 汕头 (早/港式茶点/美食街自理)

酒店：头豪泰轻居酒店或同级

早餐后，前往汕头游览浪漫海岛-【妈屿岛】，享有“汕头小镰仓”之誉。【老妈宫】【小公园】，【汕头老城区+特色骑楼】集着大量建于 20 世纪初期的建筑都是老城独特的历史风情。晚上于【龙眼南路美食街】自由品尝美食，以价格亲民、宵夜种类丰富而著称，是汕头人最爱去的美食街之一，也是汕头著名的夜市小吃街。



第四天 汕头 1.5 小时 - 潮州 (早/卤鹅风味/步行街自理)

酒店：潮州凯里亚德酒店或同级

早餐后，前往潮州【品茶听潮剧+欣赏潮汕民俗“英歌舞”表演】。游览国家历史文化名城【潮州古城】曾经是“十相留声”之地，素有“海滨邹鲁”、“岭海名邦”之美誉。【甲第巷牌坊街】在繁华喧嚣的牌坊街旁，隐藏着不足 300 米长的甲第巷，集中了数十座原汁原味的明清宅院。【广济楼城门】仿宫殿式建筑，重檐歇山顶，配以玻璃瓦红彤壁，雕梁画栋，不管是白天还是夜晚都显得雄伟壮观，漫步滨江长廊。晚上观看【古城灯光秀表演】(如遇雨天则取消)。



第五天 潮州 3.5 小时 - 厦门（早/同安封肉/粤式啫啫煲料理） **酒店：厦门汉景华美达广场酒店或同级**
 早餐后，前往厦门游览千年古刹【南普陀寺】，外观厦门大学。【演武大桥观景平台+金鸡百花星光海岸】打卡厦门网红新地标。
 【沙坡尾避风坞】承载着明代以来的历史底蕴，现为年轻创业者与手艺人汇聚的创意市集，特色小店林立，交通便利，是厦门不可错过的文艺地标。车游【五彩环岛路】其建设一直奉行“临海见海，把最美的沙滩留给百姓”的宗旨，有的依山傍海，有的凌海架桥，有的穿石钻洞，建设起点高，标准严，充分体现了亚热带风光特色。



第六天 厦门 - 吉隆坡（早/姜母鸭风味/中山路自理）
 早餐后，乘渡船前往素有“海上花园、钢琴之岛、音乐之乡”美誉的【鼓浪屿】岛上遍布着各国的建筑，哥特式教堂、罗马式喷泉、中西结合的别墅…堪称【万国建筑博览】；参观万婴之母林巧稚纪念馆【毓园】，漫步在鼓浪屿的街头小巷，【港仔后沙滩】【龙头路商业街】，远眺日光岩……指定时间送往机场，乘机返回温馨的家。

Day 1 Kuala Lumpur – Xiamen (MOB)

Hotel: Urna S Hotel or similar

Meet at Kuala Lumpur International Airport, after check in, fly to Xiamen Airport, pick up and check into the hotel to rest.

Day 2 Xiamen 2.5Hrs – Yongding 2Hrs - Meizhou (B/L/D)

Hotel: Meizhou Yiquan International Hotel or similar

[Hongkeng Tulou Folk Culture Village – Zhencheng Lou (Prince of Tulou)] A famous Hakka earthen building complex known for its unique circular structure and historical value. Zhencheng Lou is one of the most iconic and well-preserved tulous, often called the "Prince of Tulou." [Hakka Museum] China's first museum dedicated to Hakka culture, showcasing the history, migration, traditions, and daily life of the Hakka people through various exhibits and artifacts. [Thousand Buddha Pagoda] A unique pagoda featuring over a thousand white jade, golden, and iron Buddha statues embedded within its walls and structure, symbolizing spiritual richness and artistic grandeur.

Day 3 Meizhou 3Hrs – Shantou (B/L/X)

Hotel: Haotai Light Stay Hotel, Shantou or similar

[Mayu Island] A small island off the coast of Shantou, offering sea views, historic temples, and a peaceful atmosphere away from the city. [Laomagong Temple] One of the oldest temples in Shantou, dedicated to Mazu, the sea goddess worshipped by coastal communities. [Xiaogongyuan] A historical plaza in the heart of Shantou, surrounded by old buildings and rich in Teochew cultural heritage. [Shantou Old Town & Historic Arcade Buildings] Explore the charming old streets lined with traditional *qilou* (arcade-style buildings), showcasing the blend of Chinese and Western architectural influences from the early 20th century. [Longyannan Road Food Street] A popular food street packed with authentic Teochew snacks and local street food — a must-visit for food lovers.

Day 4 Shantou 1.5Hrs – Chaozhou (B/L/X)

Hotel: Kyriad Hotel Chaozhou or similar

[Tea Tasting with Teochew Opera & Yingge Dance Performance] Enjoy local tea while watching a traditional Teochew opera and the energetic folk dance known as *Yingge* — a vibrant cultural showcase of Chaoshan heritage. [Chaozhou Ancient City] Explore the well-preserved old town of Chaozhou, rich in history and traditional architecture. [Paifang Street (Jiadi Lane)] A famous street lined with traditional archways (*paifang*) and ancestral homes, offering a glimpse into Chaozhou's historic neighborhoods. [Guangji Gate Tower (Guangjilou)] An ancient city gate and landmark structure, symbolizing Chaozhou's historical defense and cultural pride. [Riverside Promenade & Ancient City Light Show] Take a leisurely walk along the riverside promenade and enjoy the Chaozhou Old Town light show at night (*canceled in case of rain*)

Day 5 Chaozhou 3.5Hrs – Xiamen (B/L/D)

Hotel: Ramada Plaza by Wyndham Hanjing, Xiamen or similar

[Nanputuo Temple] A famous Buddhist temple at the foot of Wulao Mountain, known for its serene atmosphere, ancient architecture, and strong spiritual presence [Yanwu Bridge Viewing Platform + Golden Rooster & Hundred Flowers Starry Coast] Enjoy stunning coastal views from the Yanwu Bridge viewing deck, and take a stroll along the beautifully lit seaside promenade known as the “Starry Coast.” [Shapowei Art Zone] Once a fishing harbor, now a trendy waterfront area filled with art spaces, cafes, murals, and a mix of old and new charm. [Colorful Ring Road] A scenic coastal route famous for its vibrant seaside views, cycling paths, and photogenic spots — perfect for a relaxed stroll or ride.

Day 6 Xiamen – Kuala Lumpur (B/L/X)

[Gulangyu Island] A UNESCO World Cultural Heritage Site known as the "Piano Island," famous for its colonial architecture, romantic atmosphere, and car-free streets. [International Architecture Exhibition] A collection of over a hundred historic buildings showcasing diverse Western and Chinese architectural styles — a true open-air museum. [Yu Garden] A peaceful memorial garden dedicated to Lin Qiaozhi, a renowned Chinese medical pioneer, offering a quiet moment amid island greenery. [Gangzaihou Beach] A soft-sand beach ideal for relaxing, with beautiful sea views and a laid-back coastal vibe. [Longtou Road Shopping Street] The island's main commercial street, filled with local snacks, souvenirs, boutiques, and lively island energy. After dinner send to airport check-in.
